The multi engine rating allows you to fly airplanes with two or more engines. This program consists of an estimated 8 hours of dual multi instruction in Montair's Seneca aircraft. The suggested time will vary depending on your ability and previous experience. The Seneca is equipped with state-of-the-art Digital King Silver Crown Avionics, including a GPS. It also has a dual axis autopilot and is turbocharged.

The multi engine rating offered by Montair follows the guidelines set out in the Canadian Aviation Regulations and the Multi Engine Class Rating Flight Test Guide published by Transport Canada.
